LSS CHOICES has created a "Love shouldn't hurt" mirror cling to be placed in restrooms or other public spaces throughout our county to help raise awareness of this issue as well as provide quick and safe assistance for those who are current victims of domestic violence.



How to get involved

Churches are a great place to share about the resources available to victims of abuse. Mirror clings can be put up in your men's and women's public restrooms or other appropriate spaces. How to Place the CHOICES Mirror Cling

Place cling in the bottom corner of the mirror of a public restroom. It should be easily visible without blocking or obstructing the mirror. The square shape of the mirror cling is ideal for fitting into corners and edges. One mirror cling per mirror should be sufficient. Please use your judgment when placing in a restroom with multiple mirrors, as we do not intend to clutter up these public spaces but be visible enough to be helpful to those who need to see the message of the mirror cling.
