ASSEMBLE AND DONATE CARE KITS FOR RESIDENTS AT FAITH MISSION AND CHOICES

The Lutheran Social Services Network of Hope provides hope and healing for people in crisis, allowing them to overcome barriers to becoming self-sufficient.

LSS Faith Mission in Columbus and Fairfield County provide caring support to homeless men and women transitioning into permanent housing by providing emergency shelter, nutritious meals, job and life skill support, and case management services. Medical, dental, vision and behavioral health services are also provided at our Columbus location.

LSS CHOICES for Victims of Domestic Violence is the only domestic violence shelter and 24-hour crisis and information hotline in Franklin County. CHOICES also offers counseling services and support groups, legal and community advocates, and domestic violence awareness and prevention education.

At Faith Mission and CHOICES, the healing process begins when you step in the door. You can help by providing our shelter residents with Care Kits.
