# Diamond **Thought She Was** Going to Die

#### YOU HELPED HER LEARN TO LIVE AGAIN.

Like many women in abusive relationships, Diamond, who is 22, had been surprised by her boyfriend's violent change of character. She had accepted that he was "not an easytempered person." But only five months in, she says, "His random anger was just bursting. He was not able to control his temper." A few weeks later, Diamond ended the relationship. As she was walking out, her boyfriend met her at the bottom of the stairs and shot her in the face.

The bullet went through Diamond's cheek and down her throat, landing at her esophagus. "I didn't know I was shot right away," she recalls. "When I realized the bullet went in my face, my first thought was that I was going to die. I did my best to stay calm."

Diamond's boyfriend called the police and turned himself in. Diamond was rushed to the hospital for emergency surgery. After being in a coma for two weeks, her ordeal was just beginning. "I fought for my life for



three weeks. My jaw was wired shut for two months. I had to relearn how to walk, how to talk — almost everything. It makes you feel genuinely helpless."

Adding to her troubles, Diamond had nowhere to go. As she recovered, she worked with staff from LSS CHOICES to write the next chapter of her life. "I came straight from rehab to CHOICES," Diamond tells us. "They reassured me that I could heal and get back on my feet here. And they were right. I feel like myself again."

Although she is completely healed physically, Diamond says, "I'm still healing on the inside." You gave her a safe place to restore her strength, her confidence and her future. She says, "I'm very thankful for CHOICES. They make sure anybody who has any type of domestic situation that drastically changes their life can get back on their feet."

### When Doran Asked for Help, You Were There for Him.

For most of his life, Doran struggled with asking other people for help. Eventually, he reached the point where he had to overcome his reluctance. After successfully fighting an unlawful eviction notice in court, Doran was glad the judge sided with him, but no longer wanted to stay in his apartment. With no other place to go, Doran came to LSS Faith Mission. It was one of the best decisions he ever made. "They've helped me in ways I didn't think they would," he said. "I don't have to do it by myself."

Thanks to you, our neighbors who struggle with hunger and homelessness are not alone. Your support for Faith Mission provides them with many resources, including meals and shelter, as well as compassion and guidance.

During his time at Faith Mission, Doran has used many different support services. He received assistance with getting his military paperwork in order. He worked with a counselor to help address issues from his past while working on planning for the future. Through our resource

center, he has started applying to jobs and searching for apartments. He has also discovered different educational and selfhelp programs that have sparked his interest. "Being here has taught me that maybe there is someone out there who can help me," he said.

In the short term, Doran is focused on finding long-term employment that he enjoys and that will pay him enough to be able to afford a nice apartment, this time with a fair landlord. He is very thankful to friends like you for all the support and care he has received at Faith Mission. He recognizes the important role it plays in the community.

"To me, Faith Mission is a safe haven: a place where you can go to get help if you want it."
